Healing arts sessions are provided for the purpose of stress reduction and relaxation. Healing arts sessions are not a substitute for medical or psychological diagnosis and treatment. Our professionals do not diagnose conditions nor do they prescribe any substances at Stewart's.

Medical Assistance

Stewart's staff, volunteers, and Board of Directors do not recommend or endorse any specific treatment, physician, or medical facility on behalf of the agency. Materials housed in the Library do not necessarily reflect the individual opinions of Stewart's staff, volunteers and Board of Directors.

Confidentiality

While Stewart's takes every effort to keep participant information private, we cannot guarantee confidentiality relating to participation in services. Information about participants is shared among Stewart's staff and select volunteers for the purposes of supervision, program planning, professional collaboration and assessments or compliance in legal mandates.
